Clinical Condition	Sleep Medicine and Ventilatory Failure Investigation and Treatment Service (VFITS)
Eligibility	Symptoms suggestive of severe OSA or OSA in a high-risk patient: severe tiredness, inappropriately falling asleep, truck driver or heavy machine operator, extensive cardiovascular history or risk factors. Symptoms suggestive of complex sleep disorder: narcolepsy,
	parasomnia or insomnia. Patients with chronic neurological conditions, advanced pulmonary disease or morbid obesity requiring assessment for ventilatory support.
Priority	Depends on clinical condition – see table of conditions by clinical urgency
Information required with referral	 History: Duration and severity of symptoms: snoring, witnessed apnoeas, restless sleep, unrefreshing sleep, tiredness, inappropriate falling asleep Driving history – risk of falling asleep while driving Heavy vehicle licence or other safety-critical occupation or recreation
	Other medical and allied health practitioners the patient has seen concerning this problem.
Investigations required with referral	Blood: FBC, U&Es, TFTs Previous sleep study
Pre-Referral management strategies (include with referral)	Avoid high risk activities such as driving if sleepy until treatment established Implement lifestyle changes if suspect OSA: - Smoking cessation - Weight loss if overweight - Reduction in alcohol intake and sedative use
