

OUTPATIENT SERVICE DESCRIPTION & TRIAGE GUIDELINES OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY / HAND THERAPY Southern Adelaide Local Health Network (SALHN)

Occupational Therapy / Hand Therapy

This document provides an overview of SALHN Occupational Therapy (OT) / Hand Therapy and Physiotherapy outpatient service. Hand Therapy services predominantly receive referrals from various hospital departments including Plastic Surgery, Orthopaedics, Rheumatology, and Paediatrics. A limited service is available for external referrers; however appointments will be based on the capacity of the service and the nature of the condition.

Hand Therapy

Provides splinting and specialised therapy programs using a variety of modalities to treat:

- Post-surgical hand conditions (e.g. tendon / nerve / bone fracture repair)
- Acute hand injuries (e.g. fracture management, amputation, burns)
- Post-acute hand injuries (e.g. fracture management, amputation, burns)
- Soft tissue hand injuries (e.g. <u>De Quervain's</u>, <u>carpal tunnel syndrome</u>)
- Chronic hand conditions (e.g. Rheumatological conditions)
- Pre-surgical assessments and treatment
- Scar management (any region of the body)
