Dignity in Care matters to us.

- 1. Zero tolerance of all forms of abuse.
- 2. Support people with the same respect you would want for yourself or a member of your family.
- 3. Treat each person as an individual by offering personalised service.
- 4. Enable people to maintain the maximum possible level of independence, choice and control.

- 7. Ensure people feel able to complain without fear of retribution.
- 8. Engage with family members and carers as care partners.
- 9. Assist people to maintain confidence and a positive self-esteem.
- 10. Act to alleviate people's loneliness and isolation.
