#### **ACT NOW**



Look for items with button batteries



Keep items & loose batteries out of reach of children



Secure the battery compartment



Dispose of them immediately and safely



## REATMENT



If you think your child has swallowed or inserted a button battery, don't wait for them to show symptoms.
