Information required with referral	<ul> <li>Diagnosis of interstitial lung disease – details/ previous investigations</li> <li>Duration and severity of respiratory symptoms (cough, wheeze, dyspnoea)</li> <li>Systemic symptoms</li> <li>occupational, recreational and travel history</li> </ul>
	Other medical and allied health practitioners the patient has seen concerning this problem.
Investigations required with referral	HRCT chest  Detailed lung function (Spirometry, gas transfer, lung volumes) - for GP referrals, may be organised on receipt of referral.
Pre-Referral management strategies (include with referral)	
Discharge Criteria/information	If condition stable discharge to care of GP.
