Better access

- > Using the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) for discharge and outpatient prescriptions.
- > Hospital pharmacies can dispense these prescriptions.

Expert advice

- > When you or your child is in hospital, you can discuss medicines with a pharmacist.

Please bring to hospital:

- > Your Medicare card and any Concession cards you have.
- > The medicines you or your child are taking and a list of all your medicines (including over-the-counter and herbal)
