## COVID-19 UPDATE 65: WEDNESDAY 22 JULY 2020

### Two new cases of COVID-19

A woman in her 50s, who has returned from interstate and had a history of overseas travel, has been diagnosed with COVID-19. She has been in quarantine since her arrival in Australia and will continue to isolate as she is considered an active case.

The second case is a woman in her 30s, who undertook mandatory quarantine in Adelaide after arriving from overseas. She is considered to have an old infection and is not an active case.

### Other COVID-19 testing options

COVID-19 tests can be booked with SA Pathology, Clinpath and Australian Clinical Labs. A GP referral form is required. All three providers offer drive through testing.
