SA helps fight Victorian outbreak

Today 17 nurses and midwives, along with 13 paramedics, travelled to Melbourne to join the effort to contain Victoria's recent COVID-19 outbreaks.

These healthcare workers will join a team of SA Health contact tracers that travelled to Victoria last week, as well as 20 contact-tracing staff who are working remotely in Adelaide.
