New case of COVID-19

A man in his 40s who has returned from interstate has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

He had a test on day 12 of quarantine and returned a positive result. He will remain in isolation. Three close contacts are in isolation and will be contacted daily for symptom checks.

Record testing numbers

A record 4,336 tests were undertaken yesterday, which is the highest number since testing began.

Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19, no matter how mild, should seek [testing](#) and return home immediately to wait for the results.
