COVID-19 UPDATE 39: FRIDAY 15 MAY 2020

No active COVID-19 cases in South Australia

There are currently zero known active COVID-19 cases in South Australia, with 435 people recovered.

To date, SA Pathology has undertaken more than 75,000 COVID-19 tests.

It is important South Australians do not become complacent.

Important reminder for all South Australians:

- > Keep 1.5 metres distance from others
- > Download the COVIDSafe app
- > Practice good hygiene
- > Keep working from home (if possible)
- > Get tested for COVID-19 if you have the following symptoms, even if mild:
 - Fever or chills (in the absence of an alternative illness that explains these symptoms)
 - An acute respiratory infection e.g. symptoms of cough, sore throat, runny nose, or shortness of breath
 - Loss of smell or the alteration in the sense of taste

- > No new cases today
- > 439 confirmed cases in total
- > 435 people have recovered from COVID-19
- > Sadly, there have been 4 COVID-19 related deaths in SA to date
