

Streamline Non Formulary Request:

Posaconazole Injection 300mg/16.7mL

Posaconazole Injection 300mg/16.7mL is not listed on the South Australian Medicines Formulary for prophylaxis of invasive fungal infection but is available on request from Haematology or Infectious Diseases/Microbiology in compliance with the criteria outlined below.

- Consultant Haematologist OR Consultant Microbiologist OR Infectious Diseases Physician

Patient eligibility for posaconazole injection 300mg/16.7mL(all criteria must be met)

- The patient requires prophylaxis to reduce the risk of of invasive fungal infection and oral treatment is not appropriate
- There is agreement by a Consultant Haematologist / Oncologist and an Infectious Disease specialist that intravenous posaconazole is appropriate
- Duration of intravenous therapy is to be guided by ID / Microbiology and the patient will be switched to oral therapy as soon as practicable.
- The patient case notes and drug order / medication chart / EMR include the: names of the Consultant Haematologist / Oncologist and Infectious Disease specialist; the duration of intravenous therapy; and the date for review.
