Updated guidelines for licensed venues

All licenced venues are now able to begin outdoor and indoor seated dining at their premises.

Venues will be able to seat up to 20 patrons (10 people indoors and 10 people outdoors). This includes the serving of alcohol with food.

Step 2 of the South Australian Roadmap for easing COVID-19 restrictions is scheduled to begin on 5 June and more details on specific rules will be announced soon.
