Eligibility and selection criteria

We are inviting research submissions that highlight the value of allied or scientific health within SA Health. Successful submissions will be delivered in a 10-minute format with additional time for questions (approximately 5 minutes) or in a poster format.

Selection criteria:

Allied or scientific health research that is:

- close to practice
- highlights key outcomes for consumers and the health service
- demonstrates the benefit (economic, health, social, knowledge generation) of the research

Note: all submissions require line manager approval to attend and present at the forum

Objectives:

- Highlight the value of Allied and Scientific Health across SA Health
- Inspire clinicians to continue to embed research, knowledge translation and evidence informed practice into routine practice across the continuum of clinical settings and professions
- Provide SA Health Staff the opportunity to present research
- Increase staff engagement with research
- Promoting collaboration and connection across key industry partners (University, Health Translation SA, SAHMRI, SA Health, funding bodies)

Subheadings and word count

The submission form includes three subheadings – 'Abstract', 'Outcomes' and 'Impact'. All sections must be completed and together must not exceed a **total of 450 words**. Word count and content guidelines for each section are provided in the [Microsoft Form](#).

Abstract review and notification

Abstracts will be reviewed by the Allied and Scientific Health Office Committee including an external reviewer according to the selection criteria. Abstracts will be de-identified before review.

Successful applicants will be notified by email by 15 July 2024.

The 'Abstract', 'Outcomes', and 'Impact' sections of the submission must not exceed a **total of 450 words**.
