

Transition to Professional Practice Program

SA Health's Criteria for Priority Appointment

SA Health will apply criteria for prioritising the appointment of all nurse and midwife graduates to the Transition to Professional Practice Program (TPPP). Applicants must submit priority group documents as proof of their priority status when applying.

Priority Group	Criteria	Document Category (see over page)
1	Applicants of Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent	A & C
2	Residents of South Australia who are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• undertaking tertiary nursing or midwifery studies at a South Australian university campus; or• Undertaking external tertiary nursing or midwifery studies through an interstate university	B & C
3	Applicants who are living in another state or territory other than South Australia or in an overseas location	B & C

It is important that you nominate the appropriate priority group, and that you submit the required evidence to support your nomination.

Please refer to the next page for a list of acceptable documents you will be required to submit at the time of application.

Only one document from each document category will be accepted.

Please do not provide any document that contains sensitive personal information, such as a bank statement.

Documents are not required to be certified (with the exception of Aboriginality evidence), however if SA Health suspects the documents are not legitimate they may request the documents to be certified and resubmitted.

The submission of documents that do not meet these requirements may result in a delay in processing your application.



Category	Acceptable priority group documents
A	<p>Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people - provide one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letter of confirmation of Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander heritage from an incorporated indigenous organisation, stamped with their common seal • Statutory Declaration that legally declares your cultural identity, and must be certified by a Justice of the Peace
B	<p>Primary documents - provide one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current Australian or New Zealand passport • Australian birth certificate • Australian citizenship certificate • Certificate of Status of New Zealand Citizens in Australia • Confirmation of visa status using Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) <u>and</u> International passport
C	<p>Proof of residential address - provide one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current Australian driver's license • Proof of age card • Mail with name of applicant (eg. utility bill, phone bill, council rates) . <i>Do not provide sensitive documents including bank statements with private information.</i>

At least one document must contain photo identification (eg. passport, drivers licence, proof of age card)
