

## Confirmed Malignancy

### LUNG CANCER

- Biopsy proven
- Metastatic disease
- Recurrence following previous treatment

### Information Required

- Presence of Red Flags
- Detailed history of presenting signs and symptoms
- Past medical history and current medications, allergies
- All prior relevant investigations and imaging (and provider)
- Previous histology results

### Investigations Required

- CXR
- Bloods, CBE/EUC/LFT including
- CT staging chest, abdomen and pelvis

\*NOTE: Appropriate clinical data would facilitate in prompt appointment scheduling

## Red Flags

### Present to **Emergency Department**

- ▄ Febrile Neutropenia
- ▄ Very high calcium (>3.0 mmol/L)
- ▄ SVC obstruction
- ▄ Spinal cord compression

**Refer to LUNG CANCER RAPID ACCESS CLINIC      Ph: 8204 4942      Fax: 8204 6105**

- ▄ Haemoptysis with suspected lung cancer (abnormal chest X-ray)
- ▄ Abnormal chest x-ray suggesting cancer of the lung

### Suggested GP Management

- Refer to The Lung cancer rapid access clinic for undiagnosed suspected lung cancer
- GPs are welcome to refer directly to Medical Oncology, patients with confirmed diagnosis of lung cancer.
- Majority of referrals made to Oncology for chemotherapy comes following assessments through the treating Respiratory or Cardiothoracic Surgical teams.
- Patients on surveillance after previous treatment for lung malignancy may be referred direct to Flinders Cancer Clinic, for any cancer related issues
- Investigations – refer to *Investigations Required* above
