Referral Criteria

Appropriate referrals include patients with:

1. Patients requiring ongoing management for prior stroke or stroke-related complications
2. Patients requiring ongoing management for venous sinus thrombosis
3. Patients requiring ongoing management for carotid artery dissection
4. Patients requiring ongoing management for cerebral amyloid angiopathy
5. Patients requiring ongoing management for cerebral vasculitis causing stroke

Conditions which are **not** assessed by Stroke Clinics include:

1. Patients with acute onset of possible transient ischaemic attack symptoms within the last 4 weeks (refer to **TIA Rapid Assessment Clinic** (see below) for urgent assessment)
2. Patients with new onset acute stroke (please contact the **RAH Code Stroke Team on 0409 348 788** and send patient to the RAH Emergency Department)
3. Patients with a remote history of stroke for general review or for optimising secondary prevention, unless a complex treatment dilemma has arisen
4. Patients with recent stroke without specific ongoing diagnostic or management issue
5. Patients where the primary purpose of the review is to assess fitness to drive (consider referral to Driving Fitness Assessment Clinic through [Rehabilitation Medicine](#))

Referral Criteria

Appropriate referrals include patients with:

1. Patients with acute onset of possible transient ischaemic attack symptoms within the last 4 weeks

Conditions which are **not** assessed by TIA Rapid Access Clinics include:

1. Patients with persisting symptoms (please contact **RAH Code Stroke Team on 0409 348 788** and send patient to the RAH Emergency Department)
2. Patients with symptom onset greater than 4 weeks prior (refer to **Stroke Clinic** (see above))
