#### **Psychology Appointments** (please talk to your treating team to get a referral)

Patients, survivors, and partners/carers/family members affected by cancer at SALHN are referred to psychology to receive treatment for cancer-related distress. Common reasons for referral include depression, anxiety, adjustment/coping difficulties, fear of recurrence, grief and loss, insomnia, and pain.
