Roadmap for easing restrictions released

The South Australian roadmap for easing COVID-19 restrictions was released today.

The roadmap outlines how COVID-19 restrictions will be eased in our state, with Step 1 coming into effect on Monday 11 May.

It takes into account the specific circumstances in South Australia and a number of factors have been considered in determining what can resume and when.

The priority is to resume activities that will strengthen the community, restore the economy and improve physical and mental wellbeing as soon as possible.
