2025 Funded Influenza Program

Funded influenza vaccine should be offered to all those in the following groups:

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All MAR* persons aged 6 months and older (refer to MAR factors below) • All pregnant women • All Aboriginal** persons aged 6 months and older | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children 6 months to less than 5 years • All persons aged 65 years and older • People who are homeless*** |

All funded influenza vaccines in 2025 are quadrivalent.

Age Group	FluQuadri® 0.5ml (IM)	Vaxigrip Tetra® 0.5ml (IM)	Flucelvax® Quad 0.5ml (IM)	Fluad® Quad 0.5ml (IM)	Comments
6 months to less than 5 years	✓	✓	✗	✗	Children aged 6 months to less than 9 years receiving influenza vaccine for the first time require two doses at least four weeks apart.
5 years to less than 65 years	✗	✓	✓	✗	
65 years and older	✗	✗	✗	✓
