Referral Criteria

Appropriate referrals include patients with:

1. Suspected or confirmed multiple sclerosis – including relapsing-remitting, secondary progressive & primary progressive forms
2. Suspected or confirmed neuromyelitis optica spectrum disorders (NMOSD)
3. Optic neuritis with suspicion for multiple sclerosis
4. Suspected or confirmed myasthenia gravis or Lambert-Eaton myasthenic syndrome (LEMS)
5. Suspected or confirmed neurosarcoidosis
6. Suspected or confirmed cerebral vasculitis
7. Suspected or confirmed autoimmune encephalitis

Where you believe urgent treatment may be indicated while awaiting clinic review (e.g. acute relapse of multiple sclerosis), please do not hesitate to contact the RAH Neurology Registrar via RAH switchboard on (08) 7074 0000 for advice.

Where the request is for symptom management please consider if the problem may be more appropriately referred to a [Rehabilitation Clinic](#).

Conditions which are **not** assessed by Multiple Sclerosis/Neuroimmunology Clinics include:

1. Non-specific changes seen on an MRI Brain without any clinical symptoms to suggest a demyelinating disorder – if additional advice regarding the scan results is required, please discuss the case with the reporting radiologist in the first instance.
