### **Further easing of COVID-19 restrictions**

Restrictions are being eased in South Australia with the introduction of a 1 person per 2 square metre density rule from Monday 29 June.

COVID Safe Plans continue to be required for defined public activities.

An approved COVID Management Plan will be required for some activities, including large public gatherings. Further details will be announced soon.

A team of SA Health's contact tracing experts from the Communicable Disease Control Branch have travelled to Victoria to help prevent a potential second wave.

SA Health's public health team has over 440 contact tracers on standby to protect South Australians from COVID-19.
