## COVID-19 UPDATE 49: WEDNESDAY 17 JUNE 2020

### **South Australia man determined not an active case**

SA Health has undertaken a risk assessment for a 35-year-old man who recently returned home to Adelaide from Melbourne and had been overseas. The man tested positive for COVID-19 in Melbourne on 9 June while he was in quarantine. Following daily symptom checks, he was cleared by Victoria on 14 June.

Given recent overseas travel history, he was swabbed at Adelaide Airport upon arrival on 16 June as per standard processes. He was placed in quarantine as a precaution. The man was tested and returned a low-positive result, however, in accordance with national guidelines it has been determined that he is not an active case and there is no risk to the public.

### **New category for COVIDSafe Awards**

A new 'Other' category has been announced as part of the [COVIDSafe Awards](#).

This will allow further South Australian businesses to be recognised for their innovation and compliance with COVID-19 restrictions, including retail businesses, churches, aged care and other businesses that did not fit within the existing six categories.

To apply, businesses will need to be operating within South Australia and hold a current ABN.

A winner from each of the seven categories will be awarded \$5,000 and nominations close midnight Sunday 5 July 2020.
