

Adelaide Dental Hospital 'Wayfinding'

The Adelaide Dental Hospital is located on the corner of North Terrace and George Street, in Adelaide, just down from the new Royal Adelaide Hospital.

If you come by train, you can catch the tram from the train station to our building. Get off at the City West tram stop.

If you come by car, the closest parking is at the Adelaide Convention Centre. There are also 4 disability car parks opposite our building on North Terrace.

There are two main ways to enter the building: through the main entrance on the George Street side, and through the back entrance, where we have a drop-off zone.

The main entrance is located here, on the corner of North Terrace and George Street. Pass under the red canopy and through the sliding glass doors, where you will find the lift bay. Enter the lift and press Level 12, which will take you directly to the Adelaide Dental Hospital.

If you are being dropped off for your appointment, there is a drop off point at the back of the building. To get there, keep driving along North Terrace from the west end, past our building, and turn left just before you pass under the Morphett St bridge.

Follow this service road around the back of the buildings. You will pass some warehouse doors and then see the drop-off point for the Adelaide Dental Hospital. Enter the building via the double doors, which open when you wave your hand over the button. Down the corridor and to your right, you will find the lifts. There is a call button just around the corner from the lifts, if you need any assistance coming up to Level 12.

When you arrive at the 12th floor, you will see the yellow check-in desk for the Special Needs Unit. Our receptionists will check you in. Please make sure you bring your concession card and Medicare card every time. You will also need to bring your medical details, including a medication list, for the dentist.

Our friendly reception team will happily help you with any additional needs you have on the day. We have disability toilets available, a taxi phone in our waiting room, and quiet areas to sit if the waiting room is too noisy. If there is anything you would like to discuss with us before you come for your appointment, please ring the clinic and let us know.

Just ask, and we're happy to help.
