COVID-19 testing options

SA Health's COVID-19 testing clinics are currently experiencing an increase in waiting times.

There are other testing options available including GP-led respiratory clinics that are available for all ages, without referral and are covered by Medicare.

Alternatively, people can call their GP for an assessment and may be tested in the clinic or provided with a referral to attend a drive-through testing clinic.

Mobile COVID-19 testing services

SA Pathology is boosting COVID-19 testing services near the Victorian border in response to the outbreak.

Four new mobile collection services provide flexibility, by taking testing to communities that don't currently have access to a clinic. They can also respond to hotspots and outbreaks, if required.

Mobile services are currently in operation at Tailem Bend from 8am to 4pm, with no GP referral needed. Bordertown, Mt Gambier and Yamba mobile testing services are being utilised specifically for travellers entering SA from Victoria.
