Southern Adelaide Local Health Network (SALHN)

Diabetes Type 1 and 2

- Newly diagnosed and pre-existing Type 2 diabetes in children and adults
- Newly diagnosed and pre-existing Type 1 diabetes in children and adults
- Pregnancy in pre-existing Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes
- Gestational Diabetes

Information Required for Referral

- Reason for referral
- Presence of Red Flags
- Associated symptoms / intercurrent illness
- Current medications
- Pathology results
- Medical, psychiatric and relevant psychosocial history
- Interpreter required

For insulin initiation

- Name and dose of insulin
- Time to be given and route
- Permission to titrate or return to GP to titrate

Investigations Required for Referral

- HbA1c (if available)
- Routine Biochemistry
- Diagnostic pathology (if newly diagnosed)

Refer to Diabetes Medical referral

presence of symptoms of red flags and elevated capillary blood glucose and ketones requires urgent review. Serum pathology not essential if this will delay the time to review

Suggested GP Management

Request for insulin commencement

 Provide script and definition of starting dose, agreement or otherwise for DNE's to adjust doses per SALHN guidelines and any required changes to oral or other therapies.
