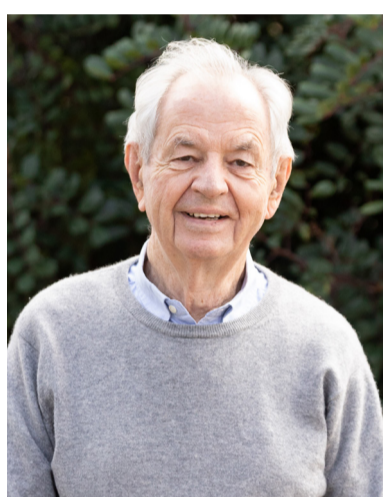


# Meet our Governing Board members
