### **COVID-19 resources for businesses**

The Australian Government has new COVID-19 resources for businesses to promote a COVIDSafe environment.

### **Testing regime expansion**

South Australia's COVID-19 testing regime will be extended with focussed testing of specific groups.

The *Active Testing Surveillance Framework* identifies specific cohorts and occupations including health care workers, residential aged care workers, transport workers, prison inmates, seasonal workers and people who are homeless.

Enhanced testing of specific groups will enable the timely implementation of any necessary control methods, including isolating cases and infection control procedures.

SA Pathology has the capacity and capability to support the continued testing of symptomatic people in addition to this targeted testing.

The COVID-19 Surveillance Committee will work with occupational groups to determine the best way to implement testing and more information will be provided when confirmed.
