

## Chronic generalised or Chronic back pain

## Definitions

- Fibromyalgia (FM): generalised arthralgia and myalgia commonly associated with allodynia, fatigue, poor • sleep pattern and psychological distress of at least 3 months duration. FM may occur with rheumatological, psychological or other conditions.
- Chronic back pain (CBP): longstanding mechanical back pain

## Differential diagnoses to consider

- FM: hypothyroidism, vitamin D deficiency, chronic arthropathy or myopathy, connective tissue disorder, 1. drug withdrawl eg. Corticosteroids, depression, paraneoplastic syndrome
- CBP: see red flags 2.

**Note:** May not need to see a rheumatologist unless there are atypical features

<b>Red Flags</b> FM: does NOT cause elevated inflammatory markers, fever, weight loss or objective signs of joint or muscle						

- disease
  - CBP: high inflammatory markers, night pain, history of malignancy, constitutional symptoms, acute on chronic back pain

•	<ul> <li>FM:</li> <li>Exploration of psychosocial issues</li> <li>Encouragement of physical activity eg.
