South Australian border restrictions

Due to the increased risk of COVID-19, restrictions on people entering South Australia from New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory will not be eased from 20 July as planned.

People entering from NSW and the ACT can still enter SA, but will need to quarantine for 14 days on arrival.

Hotel quarantine cost recovery

From 18 July, people arriving in South Australia from overseas will incur the costs for mandatory, supervised hotel quarantine.
