Cross-border travel online

From Wednesday 1 July, people entering South Australia will be able to apply for pre-approval before reaching the state's borders.

The online form is part of new measures to streamline processes and provide certainty for cross-border travellers before they reach the border.

Anyone who intends to visit or return to SA should complete the form prior to arriving, regardless of the state or territory they are travelling from.

South Australian border opening

To ensure the health and safety of South Australians, SA will no longer be opening its border to Victoria on 20 July, as planned.

The Transition Committee is still actively considering opening SA borders with New South Wales and Australian Capital Territory on that date.

The situation in Victoria will be closely monitored before any further decisions are made.
