# GP Plus Health Care Centre Marion

This fact sheet provides information for people who currently use services that will relocate to the new GP Plus Health Care Centre Marion, located at 10 Milham Street, Oaklands Park.

The centre will open in early May and provide a broad range of health services designed around the needs of children and families, youth, adults, older people and those with or at risk of chronic health conditions, including mental health.

## What is GP Plus Marion?

GP Plus Health Care Centres, together with local general practices and other health care providers, offer a broad range of health care services in the community that work together to help people stay healthy.

GP Plus Health Care Centre Marion will work with local general practices to support their role in the community. Services offered at GP Plus Marion will include healthy lifestyle programs, dental services, counselling, mental health services, early childhood development and allied health services such as podiatry, psychology and nutrition.

The centre will be open Monday to Friday, with flexibility for appointments to be arranged outside these hours. The State Aquatic Centre is also located at the site, forming a health and fitness hub for the Marion community.

## What services will be located at GP Plus Marion?

Agencies moving to the centre include Southern Primary Health Inner Southern, Southern Primary Health Marion Youth, SA Dental Service, Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service and Southern Community Mental Health. IMVS will provide a pathology collection service in the future. Other services are also being planned. Please bring your Medicare card as some services may require this.

## Opening hours:

- > Monday to Friday: 8.30am – 5.00pm
- > Weekends and public holidays: closed

## Getting there:

The centre is located at 10 Milham St Oaklands Park. A multi-story car park is available for visitors to GP Plus Marion. To park in the basement car park, enter off Milham St and use the stairs or lifts to enter the GP Plus building. Parking for people with disabilities is also located in the basement car park. A drop off zone is located on Milham St, and pedestrians can enter the GP Plus building from the plaza that runs from Morphett Rd to Warracowie Way, between GP Plus and the State Aquatic Centre. Bike parking is available in the plaza. Buses, trains and taxi ranks are also close to the centre (see overleaf for more transport information).

## Catching public transport to GP Plus Marion:

**By train:** Oaklands Train Station has 'Go Zone' bus access to GP Plus and the State Aquatic Centre every fifteen minutes. The Noarlunga Line is closed between Noarlunga Centre and Oaklands Station for about six months, as of February.

**By taxi:** Taxi ranks are located outside Marion Shopping Centre near the bus terminal on Sturt Rd, Café Primo on Level 2 and outside Woolworths. For bookings contact the following companies: Adelaide Independent 13 22 11, Yellow Cabs 13 22 27 and Suburban 13 10 08.

**By bus:** The centre is close to bus stops and 'Go Zones'. The following is a list of bus routes to and from GP Plus Marion:
