New Arrival Refugee Immunisation Program



The NARI Program aims to provide coordinated and accessible immunisation services for newly arrived refugees in South Australia.

A NARI provider can:

- > Receive and manage referrals from GPs and other health professionals
- > Make appointments for individuals and family groups
- > Provide access to interpreting services for new arrivals attending NARI clinics
- > Assess the current immunisation status of new arrivals and develop catch-up programs as required
- > Provide documentation of immunisations given and advise when immunisations are next due
