### **SAPHC Appointments**

### South Australia Mental Health Commissioner

Mr Chris Burns, South Australia Mental Health Commissioner provided an overview of the South Australian Mental Health Commission and the SA Mental Health Strategic Plan 2017-2022 (the Plan).

### **Draft State Public Health Plan 2019-2024**

The consultation process for the review of the inaugural State Public Health Plan – South Australia: A Better Place to Live has been undertaken. From this consultation process, a Summary Framework for consultation was developed. Consultation for the Summary has occurred and the State Public Health Plan 2019-2024 is currently being drafted and is nearing finalisation.

Feedback on the draft Plan will be sought from SAPHC members on aspects of the draft Plan such as:

- General comments – overall impression of the structure, language and visual appeal of the draft Plan.
- State of Public Health section.
- Regional Public Health Planning 2013-2018.
- Action areas under the four priorities.
- Appendices.
- Other comments.

### **Public Health Review Panel**

An application for review to the Public Health Review Panel, pursuant to section 95 of the Act was received.

The application applied for a review by the Panel of a Notice to secure compliance with requirements imposed under the South Australian Public Health (Wastewater) Regulations 2013.


Section 95 of the Act only provides for a right to review a Notice issued to secure compliance with the duty under Part 6 of the Act (the General Duty in section 56 of the Act).

The applicant has a right to appeal to the District Court against the Notice (section 96 of the Act).

### **South Australian Public Health Council Annual Report**

As required by section 35 of the Act, the SAPHC must, on or before 31 October in each year, provide to the Minister a report on its activities for the financial year ending on the preceding 30 June.

The Minister must, within 12 sitting days after receipt of a report under this section, cause a copy of the report to be laid before both Houses of Parliament.
