COVID-19 UPDATE 60: WEDNESDAY 15 JULY 2020

Further testing underway into possible case

This person has a history of overseas travel and initial South Australian results were inconclusive and may represent an old infection. The person will remain in isolation until the results of further tests are clear.

As is usual practice, SA Health will provide an update once the latest test results are available, which are expected to be within the next 24 hours.

SA Health text alerts

SA Health are sending text alert messages to people who have entered South Australia from Victoria since the border restrictions changed on 9 July. These messages advise people to get tested in the first 24 hours and on day 12 of their 14 day self-quarantine period.

These messages will be sent daily to SA residents who have returned from Victoria and are self-quarantining.

Some essential travellers crossing the border will have received the text alert, however, essential travellers only need to be tested if symptoms develop (even if symptoms are very mild).
