### Bus, Train and Tram

Adelaide Metro offers a Regular 28-Day pass for \$99.00 which allows unlimited travel on all bus, train and tram services for 28 consecutive days. This provides greater flexibility and more affordable travel options than standard metroCARD fares.

Cycling enthusiasts or people looking for an extra way to keep fit can visit the Department for Transport, Energy and Infrastructure's Cycle Instead Journey Planner.

This interactive tool generates cycling routes using Adelaide's *Bikedirect* network of roads, bike lanes, local streets and bike paths, and considers options such as fitness and confidence levels, road conditions and speed of travel.
