## Central Adelaide Infectious Disease Service Clinical Information Sheet

Patients with viral hepatitis may be referred to the infectious diseases unit or the gastroenterology and hepatology services.

Patients with known cirrhosis or decompensated liver disease should be directed to the gastroenterology unit.

All other patients may be seen by either infectious diseases or gastroenterology clinicians.

| Investigations<br>required with<br>referral | Hep C: Hep C Ab, if +ve, HCV-RNA- qualitative & genotyping Hep B: Hep B S Ab, Hep B S Ag, Hep B cAb, if Hep B S Ag + , HBV e antigen/antibody, Hepatitis Delta ab and HBV DNA PCR (if none done within 12 months) Hep A Ab , HIV CBE, LFTs INR Alpha-fetoprotein Liver/biliary tree ultrasound (within 6 months)  |
