Outbreak linked to NSW hotel

SA Health has been notified by NSW Health of a significant outbreak of COVID-19 cases linked to the Crossroads Hotel, Liverpool in Sydney.

The hotel is on the Hume Highway and is a popular stop for interstate truck drivers.

Anyone who visited the hotel between 3-10 July must:

- > immediately self-isolate until 14 days after they were last there
- > attend a clinic for testing even if there are no symptoms present
- > watch for symptoms and get retested should any respiratory symptoms occur, no matter how mild
- > stay in isolation for the full 14 days, even if they receive a negative result.
