DID YOU KNOW?

The **2** year program consists of **4** rotations allowing residents to work in teams across a range of SA Pharmacy sites including regional areas, developing flexibility and adaptability.



Pharmacists will work with a mentor in a supportive environment, delivering the best possible patient care.



Pharmacists will take part in drug protocol development, practice their leadership and develop self-evaluation skills and independent learning.

By working in regional areas, pharmacists will work in a variety of areas in medicine and are heavily involved in multidisciplinary settings.



Pharmacists will also see a diverse range of patients, from neonates to geriatrics, developing close working relationships.
