The education program

Our education program extends beyond the conventional AMC curriculum, placing a strong emphasis on rural health and regional expertise. Here's what it includes:

- Alignment with the AMC curriculum with a specific focus on rural medicine
- Supervision and education delivered by a diverse range of local GPs, Rural Generalists, Specialists, and other healthcare professionals
- Regular simulation (SIM) sessions to enhance practical skills
- Additional opportunities for skill development, such as Advanced Life Support, Neonatal Life Support, Regional X-ray licence, and more.
