COVID-19 vaccine trial

The first [human trials](#) of a COVID-19 vaccine developed in Australia have begun at PARC Clinical Research at the Royal Adelaide Hospital.

The first stage of the trial will involve 40 pre-screened candidates receiving two doses of the vaccine three weeks apart.

Results of the first trial will be available in around two months' time.
