Easing of some restrictions brought forward

As of Friday 22 May, South Australian cafes and restaurants will be able to seat up to 20 patrons (10 people indoors and 10 people outdoors). This includes the serving of alcohol with food.

Also announced today, step 2 of the roadmap on easing restrictions in South Australia will now come into effect earlier on Friday 5 June.
