## COVID-19 UPDATE 57: FRIDAY 10 JULY 2020

### **Urgent testing reminder**

There is a higher risk of COVID-19 in South Australia due to the outbreak in Victoria.

Anyone with symptoms (fever, cough, fatigue, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath or loss of taste or smell) should get tested for COVID-19, even if symptoms are mild.

### **COVID Management Plan template available**

[COVID Management Plans](#) templates and guidelines are now available online. High-risk public activities that require a plan include:

- > Gatherings and activities of more than 1,000 people.
- > Licenced premises under the Liquor Licencing Act 1997 where both dancing and the consumption of liquor occurs.
- > Nightclubs where the principle purpose of the premise is for the consumption of liquor, playing of loud, amplified music, and dancing.

All COVID Management Plans will be reviewed by SA Health and the assessment process may involve site visits and inspections.

If there is an increase in community transmission of COVID-19, existing COVID Management Plans may be reviewed to ensure activities are still safe to proceed. In the event of a widespread outbreak, approval for COVID Management Plans may need to be revoked.
