

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO NEGOTIATE AN ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT UNDER THE  
FAIR WORK ACT 1994**

**TO ALL SALARIED MEDICAL OFFICERS COVERED BY THE SA HEALTH SALARIED  
MEDICAL OFFICERS ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT 2017**

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive, Department of Treasury and Finance proposes to begin negotiations for a new enterprise agreement.

The proposed date and time for commencement of negotiations is on **Tuesday 22 September 2020 at 1.00pm**

The proposed place for commencement of negotiations is **Level 1 Training Room, State Administration Centre, 200 Victoria Square, Adelaide.**

It is proposed that the enterprise agreement will bind the following employees: Salaried Medical Officers referred to as Interns, Limited Registration Medical Practitioners, Medical Practitioners, Senior Registrars, Senior Medical Practitioners, Medical Officers (as defined), Consultants and Senior Consultants.

It is proposed that the enterprise agreement will not bind the following employees:


- Those persons employed pursuant to the *SA Health Visiting Medical Specialists Enterprise Agreement 2019*;
- Those persons employed pursuant to the *SA Health Senior Visiting Neurosurgeons Agreement 2013*;
- Those persons employed by Health Units as Clinical Academics and bound by the *SA Health Clinical Academics Enterprise Agreement 2018* in respect of their employment as Clinical Academics;
- The University of Adelaide and employees thereof in respect of employment by the University of Adelaide of such employees;
- The Flinders University of South Australia and employees thereof in respect of employment by the Flinders University of South Australia in respect of such employees.

Employees have the right to be represented in the negotiation of, and in any proceedings for the approval of, the enterprise agreement by an employee association registered under the *Fair Work Act 1994*, or another agent of their choice.

Employees to be involved in these negotiations can gain access to current copies of the relevant industrial instruments, *South Australian Medical Officers Award* and the *SA Health Salaried Medical Officers Enterprise Agreement 2017*, which currently regulate their employment, by contacting the Human Resources Unit of their health unit or agency or through the internet as follows:
