Referral Criteria

Appropriate referrals include patients with:

1. Tremor
2. Involuntary movements suggestive of chorea, tics, myoclonus or dystonia
3. Ataxia of uncertain cause
4. Spasticity of undetermined cause
5. Suspected or confirmed Parkinson's disease
6. Suspected or confirmed atypical parkinsonism
7. Gait disorders of uncertain aetiology
8. Suspected or confirmed Huntington's disease

Where patients are of an advanced age (>80 years) and/or have significant co-morbidities (e.g. dementia), please consider if they would be more appropriately referred to a General Medical or [Geriatric Clinics](#)

Where you believe treatment may be indicated while awaiting clinic review (e.g. suspected diagnosis of Parkinson's disease), please do not hesitate to contact the Neurology Registrar via switchboard on (08) 7074 0000 for advice.

Where there is an established cause for the patient's symptoms, referral to another clinic may be more appropriate (e.g. patients with post-stroke spasticity are more appropriately referred to a [Rehabilitation Clinic](#)).
