Clinical Condition	Suspected or Proven Interstitial Lung Disease RAH Complex interstitial lung disease (OLIV Clinic) – Referral from Specialist Physician/ Respiratory Advanced Trainee only
Eligibility	Patients with evidence of Interstitial Lung Disease
Priority	
Information required with referral	History <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Diagnosis of interstitial lung disease – details/ previous investigations</li><li>• Duration and severity of respiratory symptoms (cough, wheeze, dyspnoea)</li><li>• Systemic symptoms</li><li>• occupational, recreational and travel history</li></ul> Other medical and allied health practitioners the patient has seen concerning this problem.
Investigations required with referral	HRCT chest  Detailed lung function (Spirometry, gas transfer, lung volumes) - for GP referrals, may be organised on receipt of referral.
Pre-Referral management strategies (include with referral)	
Discharge Criteria/information	If condition stable discharge to care of GP.
